



Dean's Scholarship (No Application)

The Dean's scholarship is offered to students in the Master's Program who have achieved academic excellence. Students entering the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th semesters in Spring 2021 will be evaluated and chosen based upon academic merit. Non-degree students or students who receive full scholarships from external institutions (GKS, POSCO, etc.) are not eligible for the Dean's scholarship.

1. Eligibility

- A. Full-time students during the Fall 2020 semester (**minimum 12 credits**) with a **GPA of 4.0/4.3 or above**
- B. Full-time students who are entering their 2nd, 3rd, or 4th semester in the Spring 2021 semester
- C. Only students who have fulfilled the core course requirements (including students who were able to waive core courses) are eligible to apply for the Dean's scholarship.

2. Evaluation Criteria: Fall 2020 GPA, Number of credits, CGPA, etc.

3. Amount: 50% - 100% of tuition

4. Number of Recipients: 10 - 15

5. Announcement of the Final Result (Expected): middle of February by email

* Students who take a leave of absence during the Spring 2021 semester will not receive the Dean's Scholarship.

* **Dean's list and Dean's scholarship are different. (Those who are on Dean's list might not get the Dean's scholarship.)** Depending on the budget for the semester and the academic performance of the students on the list throughout the semester, scholarships will be given to the top-ranked students. Therefore, not all students on the Dean's list will be able to receive.

Financial Aid (Application Necessary)

Financial Aid is offered to students in the Master's Program who have achieved academic excellence and are in need of financial aid. Students entering the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th semesters in Spring 2021 will be evaluated and chosen based upon academic merit and financial need. Non-degree students or students who receive full scholarships from external institutions (GKS, POSCO, etc.) are not eligible to apply for financial aid.

1. Eligibility

- A. Full-time students during the Fall 2020 semester (**minimum 9 credits**) with a **GPA of 3.5/4.3 or above**



- B. Full-time students who are entering their 2nd, 3rd, or 4th semester in the Spring 2021 semester
- C. Only students who have fulfilled the core course requirements (including students who were able to waive core courses) are eligible to apply for the financial aid.

2. Evaluation Criteria: Fall 2020 GPA, demonstrated need for financial assistance, etc.

3. Application Period: Tuesday, December 29 – Monday, January 11

4. Amount: 1/6 - 1/2 of tuition

5. Number of Recipients: 30 - 40

6. Announcement of the Final Result (Expected): middle of February by email

7. Method of Submission: In person at GSIS office, mail, or email(gsis@yonsei.ac.kr)

8. Important Things to Know before Applying

- A. Applications without enough supporting documents could be disqualified.
- B. Scholarship decisions will not change after all applications are submitted.
- C. Additional documents may be requested if we deem it necessary.
- D. All submitted documents will not be returned to the students in any case.
- E. Students who take a leave of absence during Spring 2021 will not receive financial aid.

9. Application Documents / Requirements:

For Korean Students:

- A. 지원서 (첨부 양식) 1 부 (첨부 양식-20201222 수정됨)
- B. 장학금 신청사유서 (1 ~ 2페이지 분량의 자유 양식으로 사유 상세히 기재, 국/영문 모두 가능)
- C. 주민등록등본
- D. '부' 또는 '모' 기준 가족관계증명서
- E. Agreement for Collection and Use of Personal Data (첨부 양식-20201222 수정됨)
- F. 지방세 (재산세, 종합토지세) 세목별 과세증명서
 - 1) 타 지역분 포함, 본인 / 부 / 모 각각의 명의로 모두 제출(총 3 부)
 - 2) 원칙적으로 5만원 이하인 자만 가능
 - 3) 과세 사실이 없는 경우 미과세증명서로 대체하여 반드시 제출
- G. 근로소득원천징수영수증
 - 1) 본인 / 부 / 모 각각의 명의로 모두 제출(총 3 부)
 - 2) 직장인일 경우 제출하며, 원칙적으로 연간소득 2,400 만원 미만인 자만 가능 (해당 직장에서 발급)
- H. 건강보험료 납부확인서
 - 1) 본인 / 부 / 모 각각의 명의로 모두 제출(총 3 부)
 - 2) 피부양자의 경우 건강보험 자격득실확인서로 대체하여 제출
 - 3) 원칙적으로 4 만 5 천원 이하인 자만 가능 - 건강보험관리공단지부에서 발급



I. 기타 가계 곤란을 증빙할 수 있는 서류(학자금 대출 증빙서류 등)

* 위의 원칙적인 기준에 해당되지 않더라도 서류 제출 가능

* A, B, C, D, E, F는 공통 필수 제출 서류이며, 근로소득자의 경우 G, 자영업자(농, 어업종사자 포함)의 경우 H의 서류를 반드시 제출

* 국민기초생활 보장법에 의한 국민기초생활수급자 또는 차상위계층인 가정은 해당 증명서(수급자증명서 또는 차상위계층 증명서)와 위의 A, B, C, D, E 공통 필수 서류만 제출

For Non-Korean / International Students:

All documents should be submitted **in English or in Korean**. Notarized translations are acceptable.

[REQUIRED]

- A. Completed Application Form (view attached)
- B. Personal Statement (freeform of 1 - 2 pages) explaining your need for financial assistance
- C. Agreement for Collection and Use of Personal Data (view attached – 20201222 updated)
- D. Copies of Income Statements from both of your parent(s) or guardian(s) for the last six or twelve months **AND Explicitly write their monthly or annual income (the exact amount) and explaining the document you submitted**
- E. Copy of the Certificate or Proof of Income Deposit of your Part-Time Work (only applicable if you have a part-time work)

[Submit one or more of the following]

- F. Documents Demonstrating Financial Need. Examples are as follows:
 - 1. Copies of Student Loan, Credit Card, or Banking Statements for the past six to twelve months
 - 2. Copy of your Lease / Housing Agreement in Korea
 - 3. Copies of Tax Statements from both you and your parent(s) or guardian(s) if applicable
 - 4. Copies of Unemployment or Bankruptcy by both you and your parent(s) or guardian(s)
 - 5. Other income/asset/financial information documentation

* The more supporting documents you submit from option F, the higher your chance of receiving financial aid will be.
