



## Dean's Scholarship (No Application)

The Dean's scholarship is offered to students in the Master's Program who have achieved academic excellence. Students entering their 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> semesters in Fall 2021 will be evaluated and chosen based upon academic merit. Non-degree students or students who receive full scholarships from external institutions (GKS, POSCO, etc.) are not eligible for the Dean's scholarship.

### 1. Eligibility

- A. Full-time students during the Spring 2021 semester (**minimum 12 credits**) with a **GPA of 4.0/4.3 or above**
- B. Full-time students who are entering their 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, or 4<sup>th</sup> semester in the Fall 2021 semester
- C. Only students who have fulfilled the core course requirements (including students who were able to waive core courses) are eligible to apply for the Dean's scholarship.

**2. Evaluation Criteria:** Spring 2021 GPA, Number of credits, CGPA, etc.

**3. Amount:** 50% - 100% of tuition

**4. Number of Recipients:** 10 - 15

**5. Announcement of the Final Result (Expected):** middle of August by email

\* Students who take a leave of absence during the Fall 2021 semester will not be eligible to receive the Dean's Scholarship.

\* **Dean's list and Dean's scholarship are different. (Those who are on Dean's list might not get the Dean's scholarship.)** Scholarships will be given to top ranked students on the Dean's list depending on the budget for the semester and academic performance. Therefore, not all students on the Dean's list will be able to receive a scholarship.

## Financial Aid (Application Necessary)

Financial Aid is offered to students in the Master's Program who have achieved academic excellence and are in need of financial aid. Students entering the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> semesters in Fall 2021 will be evaluated and chosen based upon academic merit and financial need. Non-degree students or students who receive full scholarships from external institutions (GKS, POSCO, etc.) are not eligible to apply for financial aid.

### 1. Eligibility



A. Full-time students during the Spring 2021 semester (**minimum 9 credits**) with a **GPA of 3.5/4.3 or above**

B. Full-time students who are entering their 2nd, 3rd, or 4th semester in the Fall 2021 semester

C. Only students who have fulfilled the core course requirements (including students who were able to waive core courses) are eligible to apply for the financial aid.

**2. Evaluation Criteria:** Spring 2021 GPA, demonstrated need for financial assistance, etc.

**3. Application Period:** Wednesday, July 7 – Friday, July 16

**4. Amount:** 1/6 - 1/3 of tuition

**5. Number of Recipients:** 5 - 10

**6. Announcement of the Final Result (Expected):** middle of August by email

**7. Method of Submission:** In person at GSIS office, mail, or email(gsis@yonsei.ac.kr)

**8. Application Documents / Requirements:**

**For Korean Students:**

A. 지원서 (첨부 양식) 1 부

B. 장학금 신청사유서 (1 ~ 2 페이지 분량의 자유 양식)

C. 가족관계증명서 또는 주민등록등본

D. Agreement for Collection and Use of Personal Data (첨부 양식)

E. 지방세 (재산세, 종합토지세) 세목별 과세증명서 1 부

1) 타 지역분 포함, 본인 및 부모 모두 제출

2) 원칙적으로 5만원 이하인 자만 가능

3) 과세 사실이 없는 경우에도 반드시 제출 (미과세증명서 제출)

F. 근로소득원천징수영수증 1 부

1) 본인 및 부모 모두 제출

2) 직장인일 경우 제출하며, 원칙적으로 연간소득 2,400 만원 미만인 자만 가능 (해당 직장에서 발급)

G. 지역건강보험료납입증명서 1 부

1) 본인 및 부모 모두 제출

2) 직장인이 아닌 경우 (자영업자, 기타 등)만 제출

(단, 피부양자의 경우 건강보험자격득실확인서로 제출)

3) 원칙적으로 4 만 5 천원 이하인 자만 가능 - 건강보험관리공단지부에서 발급

H. 기타 가계 곤란을 증빙할 수 있는 서류(학자금 대출 증빙서류 등)

\* A, B, C, D, E 는 공통 필수 제출 서류이며, 근로소득자의 경우 F, 자영업자(농, 어업종사자 포함)의 경우 G 의 서류를 반드시 제출



\* 국민기초생활보장법에 의한 기초생활수급자 및 차상위계층인 가정은 장학금 신청서와 해당 증명서만 제출

**For Non-Korean / International Students:**

All documents should be submitted **in English or in Korean**. Notarized translations are acceptable.

**[REQUIRED]**

- A. Completed Application Form (view attached)
- B. Personal Statement (freeform of 1 - 2 pages) explaining your need for financial assistance
- C. Agreement for Collection and Use of Personal Data (view attached)

**[Submit one or more of the following]**

- D. Documents Demonstrating Financial Need. Examples are as follows:
  - 1. Copies of Student Loan, Credit Card, or Banking Statements for the past six to twelve months
  - 2. Copy of your Lease / Housing Agreement in Korea
  - 3. Copy of your Certificate of Part-Time Work
  - 4. Copies of Tax Statements from both you and your parent(s) or guardian(s) if applicable
  - 5. Copies of Salary Statements from both you and parent(s) or guardian(s) for the last six or twelve months
  - 6. Copies of Unemployment or Bankruptcy by both you and your parent(s) or guardian(s)
  - 7. Other income/asset/financial information documentation

\* The more supporting documents you submit from option D, the higher your chance of receiving financial aid will be.

\* **Applications without enough supporting documents could be disqualified.**

\* **Scholarship decisions will not change after all applications are submitted.**

\* **Students who take a leave of absence during Fall 2021 will not receive financial aid.**
