- All students are **required** to complete all core courses in their first semester. If you do not, you will not be eligible for scholarships such as Financial Aid or the Dean's Scholarship.

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

- 48 credits in total (each course is worth three credits)
 - OR 42 credits + a thesis (worth six credits)
- Minimum GPA of 3.0/4.3
- Completion of Core Courses
- Completion of Field of Concentration
- At least two years (four semesters) of full-time enrollment
- Completion of all requirements within eight semesters

- Korean Studies Majors: Completion of Course/Language Requirements of the Program
